SENIOR SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

RULES AND REQUIREMENTS

1. All graduating Plainwell High School Seniors with a G.P.A. of 2.5 or better are eligible.
2. Students in all full-time areas of study will be equally considered. All vocational, traditional and non-traditional pursuits will be accepted. PEF is interested in supporting all educational pursuits.
3. Scholarship applications must include information in the six categories below and may follow whatever format the applicant desires. Proper grammar and word usage will be considered. Students may submit an application in a form other than the one provided by PEF.
4. Scholarships will vary in amount depending on the number of applicants and funds available. Decisions of the PEF Scholarship Award Committee are final.
5. All information in each application will be kept confidential by PEF.
6. Applications should be turned in to the Plainwell High School Guidance Office by the third Friday in April.

Selections are based on the following six categories. All six must be submitted.

1. School Statistics: G.P.A., school-related activities and achievements. Please include your grade transcripts.
2. Non-school Related Activities and Achievements: Work, community, help to others, responsibilities, commitments, recreations, hobbies, etc.
3. Post High School Educational Plans: Where are you going; what will you be studying; how much will it cost for one year; how do you plan to finance your education; what other scholarships have you received or expect to receive?
4. Family Financial Information: If financial considerations other than that provided on page 1 of the application exist that you feel we should know about, please include them in "Other Considerations" on page 2 of the application or in your essay.
5. Essay (or other form): Tell us about yourself and your career/educational goals. Who and/or what was your greatest influence in deciding your career/educational goals? Include any other information you would like us to know.
6. One letter of recommendation from a staff member and one letter of recommendation from someone outside the school (not a family member).
